The White Cat

By Mrs. Florence Kemmer

The long-haired white cat is a lovely animal and if kept clean, groomed, and in good condition, its beauty is hard to surpass. That the white cat retains in some measure that peculiar woolliness of coat, longer body and tail, more pointed face and close-set ears, is not to be wondered at, as they are the natural linear descendants of the Angora. They are dominant in both color and type. To broaden the head, give width between the ears, shorten the legs, body and tail, improve eye color and length of coat, an outcross to the blue Persian was made. After years of breeding whites to blues, which are the most nearly perfect of the Persians, a decided improvement in the whites has been made.

White cats have blue eyes, copper eyes or one eye of each color (odd-eyed whites). To breed the blue-eyed, whites are usually used, but after two or three generations, in spite of the most selective breeding, they have a tendency to revert to the more pointed features. An outcross to a blue, preferably with yellow eyes but with the desired head and body type, is used. Golden-eyed kittens, which result from such a mating, almost always have very pale yellow eyes, but if mated

to a good copper-eyed cat their kittens have deep copper eyes. The blue-eyed kittens from this mating usually have deeper blue eyes because the pigment in the blue coat enhances the color.

Some people believe all white cats are deaf, others that all blue-eyed whites are deaf. Any white cat, regardless of the color if its eyes can be deaf. It is more frequent in the blue-eyed white. It has been proven by laboratory tests that such a cat has an abnormal anatomical condition of the inner ear mechanism which is due and directly related to the factor of complete albinism. The term albino is usually applied to human beings or other animals whose skin, hair and eyes show radical differences from normal because of the absence of pigment, that is, coloring matter. Albinism may be partial or complete. Among the lower animals, white mice, white rabbits, and white poultry are examples of albinism that has been fixed by heredity. It is popularly supposed that an albino is weaker in constitution than normal beings but experiments have failed to show proof of this. Some are at a disadvantage, however, because of their deafness. Any white cat could carry the albino gene from generation to generation

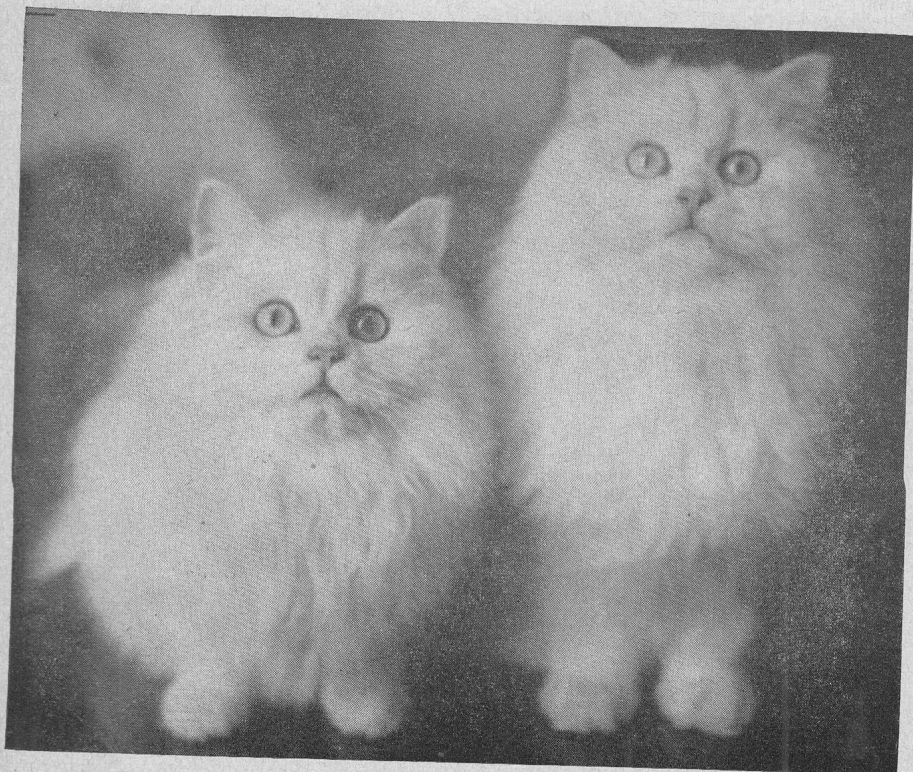
and not reveal its presence unless it was mated to another cat carrying the same gene for albinism, and deafness would not result. Some breeders believe deafness can be bred out by using only sound hearing cats but this has been proved false, and after two or three years of breeding with no deaf kittens a whole litter of deaf kittens may put in their appearance. The chromosome in the gene is the only bridge of inheritance and chance is the controlling influence as to which chromosome is retained in the fertilized egg. As a result sound hearing cats do not always produce sound hearing white kittens and the owner condemns both the breeder and the pedigree.

Many novice breeders of blue-eyed whites start with high hopes, for these animals are truly attractive and admired by all who see them. However, the arrival of deaf kittens soon discourages them and they either change to some other color or a breeder is lost to the cat fancy. While everyone prefers a sound hearing cat, deafness does not keep a white cat from being shown and many are so smart and pick up vibrations so quickly that it is sometimes hard to detect their lack of hearing.

Each chromosome is made up of genes arranged in linear order. Breaks in the pair may result in an exchange of parts between them, a crossing over. This may be the explanation of odd-eyed whites. The gene carrying color has relocated, causing color to be deposited in the eye. Most breeders consider an odd-eyed cat an exceptionally good producer of sound hearing blue-eyed kittens, but she can be used equally well to produce copper-eyed kits.

The golden- or copper-eyed white is much easier to produce and you are almost always sure of the result. Two good golden-eyed whites or a good golden-eyed white and good blue will generally produce the desired result. Where blue is used there are usually three white kittens to one blue, but often these white kittens will be born with a blue spot on the top of the head. These spots range from a few dark hairs to nearly the whole top of the head. They almost always disappear when the kitten loses its kitten coat and gets its permanent coat at maturity. Many breeders think it necessary to breed colorbred whites, but since white is dominant for color, white kittens are known to have been produced where the pedigree is as much as seven-eighths colorbred blue. But one parent must always be white, preferably the mother.

Western Loss

"She knew aught save kindness . . ."

The Pacific Northwest lost a notable member of the cat fancy on January 15th, when (Ruth B.) Mrs. Mervill G. Stevens, Tang Wong Cattery, Seattle, was fatally injured in a traffic accident on the Seattle-Tacoma highway. The tragedy occurred during the worst snow-fall this area has seen for several years.

Mrs. Stevens was a teacher of art at the Federal Way School and had held similar posts in Pacific Northwest schools for many years. She was graduated from the University of Washington in 1918 and was a member of Lambda Rho, honorary art society, the Seattle Cat Club and the Siamese Cat Society of America.

Mrs. Stevens was recognized as one of the country's outstanding breeders of Siamese and Burmese, and was reported to have around 75 fine cats and kittens at Tang Wong.

Her crowded schedule never seemed to limit her; she had time for everyone. It was hard to understand how she managed, but Ruth Stevens was a universally-minded woman and served universally. She had the interests of others at heart and proved it at every turn.

The cat hobby started with Mr. and Mrs. Stevens in September of 1939, when they bought a Siamese female kitten, a Seal-point male, Tang, and two Burmese females. One of the little Burmese was Wong Mau, imported from Burma by Dr. Joseph Thompson. The other was her daughter, Wong II.

The cattery was on its way! Mr. and Mrs. Stevens immediately turned their utility-room into a temporary cattery.

The name . . . Tang, for their first Siamese male, and Wong, for their first Burmese female. The name was promptly registered by Mrs. Jessie M. Kessler, who was the secretary of the American Cat Association at that time . . . 1940.

Needless to say, there are always real problems for the novice-breeder to solve. Mistakes can be tragic, so Mr. and Mrs. Stevens sought advice from those who'd had invaluable experience and were willing to share their knowledge.

Mrs. Stevens was invited to join the Seattle Cat Club and discovered that the president was Mrs. J. Oken, who had been an esteemed breeder of Persians, but had since become a na-

tionally-known judge. Mrs. Oken generously did all she could to help Tang Wong get started. (Incidentally, Mrs. Oken was recently elected to the presidency of the Seattle Cat Club for the 25th year).

In December of 1940, the Tang Wong cats attended their first show. Although Mrs. Stevens' cats had practically no competition, it was a thrill to have Tang named Best Siamese and "Brownie," Best Burmese.

It was nine years before Seattle had the next show (war years), and, by then, there was plenty of competition. A daughter of Tang's went Best Siamese.

Mr. and Mrs. Stevens kept adding new stock by purchasing, breeding, and trading. The fine qualities of their original cats were retained by bringing in only the blood-lines that would improve them. All this called for more space, so in 1947, the cattery added a wing. Today, Tang Wong is considered a model of comfort, convenience, and workability.

The 1953 show-season (five shows) was one of realization for Mr. and Mrs. Stevens; a well-earned acknowledgment of their years of studied breeding, love, and care. Five new names from Tang Wong were added to the list of Pacific Northwest champions.

To Mr. Stevens, the deep understanding of friends far and near. It will mean a great deal to the Fancy

to know that he plans to continue the work at Tang Wong!

Western All Pets

As told by Mrs. L. L. Trautman

"Not having a cow ourselves, it was necessary to go to a nearby dairy each day for the colt's gallon of milk. For a couple of weeks, it was nip and tuck to adjust the formula to his needs. The veterinarian, Dr. Beckman, Spokane, really didn't expect him to live . . . he was just skin and bones. For the first month, orange or lemon juice had to be added to the scalded milk, lime water, and corn syrup to overcome an itchy condition of the skin. The baby formula called for cod-liver oil twice a day in his mash and three feedings had mineral mash mixed with a little of the formula. I set my alarm for 4:00 a.m., and fed the colt every four hours, starting at 4:30 a.m., and ending at 8:30 in the evening.

Because of coyotes, the colt spent his nights and any time I wasn't home, in a loose box-stall. At other times, he was in the door-yard or orchard. Never having known his mother, he followed me everywhere—close at my heels. If I sat down in the sun, he'd lie at my feet and nap. I was his father and mother!

He wasn't named until he was registered just before the New Year—1948. Farabi became his formal name, but all summer, he'd been called "Mamma's Little Red Riding Horse" and never failed to answer in his high, little voice when his name was spoken."

Want to Be A Cat Judge?

By Mabel Davidson

Perhaps you, like many others at-
tending your first cat shows, think it
must be a great deal of fun to judge;
Well, most cat judges will tell you
that they had their job thrust on them
by someone's illness or absence. This
in fact, was the reason I was first
asked to judge a cat show; the judge
was ill and could not come.

Since I had had six years of breed-
ing experience at the time, I was ask-
ed to judge the show. All I could say
was, "I'll try it."

Since the American Cat Associa-
tion had a score for the Persian I was
to judge and had been breeding, I set
about studying it. My first job as
judge was in 1923 at Indianapolis.
Since then I have successfully judged
in various places, and made many
friends along the way. In 1936 I re-
signed from the American Cat Associa-
tion and transferred to the Cat Fan-
ciers' Association.

A saying by an admired judge of
the bar has always stood out in my
memory as a fine tenet for any be-
ginning judge to follow: be complete-
ly independent and have no fear. So,
when judging, I would advise you to
close your mind to the distractions
and influences about you, and judge
the cat as you see it according to its
merits and the score of the associa-
tion for whom you are judging.

You must make a thorough enough
study of the cat to enable you to meet
any test that confronts you. You
must know your cat and its points so
well that you can show where any
animal's faults — as well as his good
points — lie. It is no small task to
score each cat and set it down for
your future records. It has been my
policy to keep this record for one
year, along with remarks on each cat.
Then if discussion comes up later, you
have your book for reference.

You must be able to meet the public
with tact and kindness, be immune to
criticism, and able to talk to the pub-
lic as you judge. I was the first judge
to make remarks during the judging.
I started this practice to help begin-
ners know more about their cats.
Earlier, people had told me that they
never knew why wins were made,
since nothing was said to the public
during the judging.

Today we have a much better stand-
ard to work with in all associations.
There are many people who breed
wonderful show stock, which indicates
their study of the cat, and these in-
dividuals would make excellent judges.
Some of them are willing to help the
people who buy from them to learn

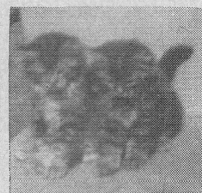

to breed correctly; but their are others who refuse this aid to the novice.

You must have at least four years of breeding winning stock before attempting to judge. This rule indicates that you know what you are doing before you enter the show ring to judge. Incidentally, it is valuable experience to work with a judge as a handler to and from the cages.

The first thing required in the breeding of cats is the study of line and color-bred stock. "Inbreeding — What It Is and What It Does" is a very helpful book by the noted English breeder and author, C. A. House.

If you are buying inquire until you find some of the breeders of outstanding winners. From one of these you will be able to purchase a good breeder, and begin your "career." It does take perseverance to make a good breeder, but there is never a win so great as the first blue ribbon. Try to breed for quality, for it takes an outstanding cat to gain top honors.

Personally, I believe in keeping just one color and breed — or in Persians, no more than two colors. My creed for breeding good stock is *line and color-bred stock*. I wish you all the success with whatever color and breed you choose, and remember — judging can be both enjoyable and rewarding.
