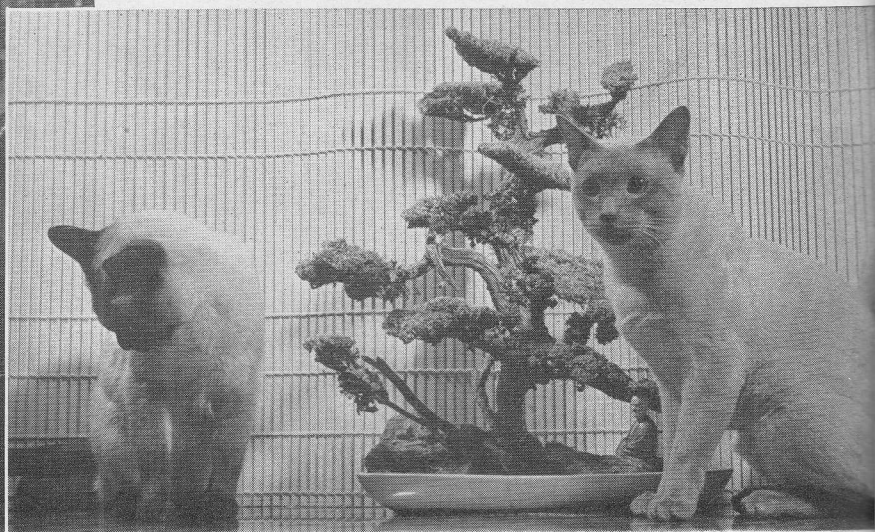


# Pirouetting Pussy

## The Siamese Hybrid

A Fancier Disagrees With  
Mr. Middleton

After reading Russell Middleton's article entitled "Science Vs. Prejudice" printed in the February issue of this magazine (page 52), I thought that perhaps Mr. Middleton himself had better learn a few things. He obviously made a lot of dogmatic statements, himself, without the proper research or background in the cat fancy. If he had he would not have come up with some rather prejudiced ideas.

Namely, he states in his article that "Red Point Siamese" were originated by Mrs. Alyce DeFilippo of Chicago and that they were developed by her from ONE SINGLE OUTCROSS TO A RED DOMESTIC SHORT HAIR. Obviously Mr. Middleton has never heard of the scarcity of the Red self and if such a colored Domestic were obtainable the Domestic breeders would consider it good fortune indeed. However, the most interesting

thing about his statement is this: Mrs. DeFilippo, herself, stated in an article written by her in the April, 1952 issue of Cats Magazine entitled "Breeding Red Point Siamese at Sundust Cattery" that she bred her Seal Point Siamese, Bonnie Blue Eyes to a red PERSIAN OF MIXED ANCESTRY. This has been the basis of her Red Point line. She was already calling the progeny "Siamese" in the second generation. The F-1 generation were short haired as were the kits in the F-2 generation. Long Hair is a recessive factor and can naturally be lost in the first generation, but it can appear again in almost any generation thereafter. Mrs. DeFilippo stated that she later bred Seal Points (Seals that were a result of the Red Point breeding) to a Red Tabby HYBRID. Mr. Middleton should think again of his bold statements cited in his article.

Many colors are dominant, others are recessive and these color factors are carried in the genes of various cats. For example, the Siamese blue eye is different from the Domestic or Long Hair blue eye.

I am not against a "new breed" of any animal if it is bred and proven properly. However, whenever a new breed is developed it is also given a NEW NAME. Just because a cat has the Himalayan restrictive factor does not necessarily make it a Siamese. The Siamese (Seal, Chocolate, Blue and Lilac) is a result of a mutated gene. Mutations are a result of climatic conditions, sudden or over a period of time, X-Ray, and of course radioactivity. Man has not entered into the picture here. In the case of the Red Point, nature isn't the artist.

Of course, at one time or another, Siamese have been bred with Domestics or Long Hairs, but this is why the Siamese breeders and registering organizations are so careful in their acceptance. Need I mention here the reason for white toes appearing in certain cases?

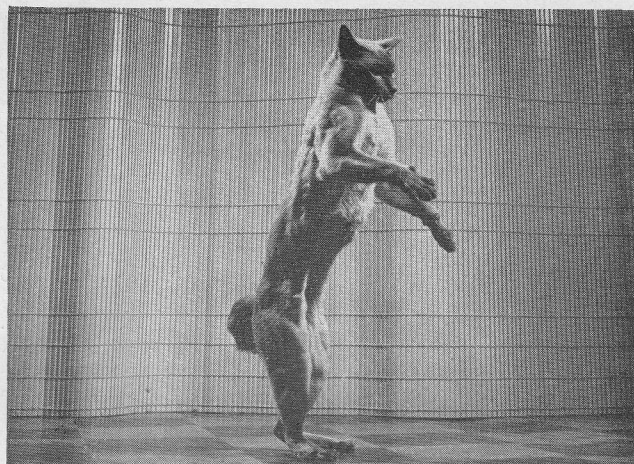
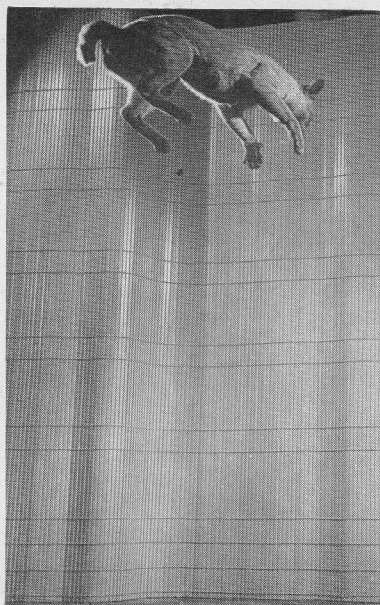
There is no reason for any of us to doubt the origin of the Seal, Blue, Lilac or Chocolate Point; research and evidence has proven that. For

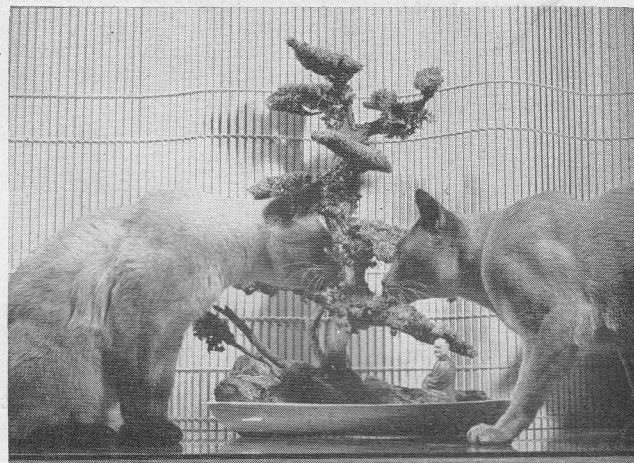

To Relax Are Key  
Qualities Needed

*Trick Cat . . .*

Through many years of teaching cats to perform from three to 15 tricks, I can state through my own experiences the qualities that have proved most successful in selecting a feline easily adaptable to trick training.

We all know that personality as in people is also most essential in performing cats. Stubbornness is very bad and a cat that is too energetic and not relaxed can prove very provoking. Also, a lazy cat is equally as impossible. A well-balanced, intelligent, healthy and loving creature will try to show his appreciation and devotion by doing the bidding of his master or mistress.

In one of Lanny Lea's Trick Cat's performances he proved that stubbornness can be very devastating. He had dutifully sat in his highchair with bib, spoon and dish, then "read" the newspaper with donned eyeglasses, when a canary began chirping and a parrot started making himself heard. That was it! Lanny Lea, as most cats, wanted to watch the little feathered creatures. He was very perturbed at not being allowed this privilege. He made it very obvious that he was indignant and did not want to show off.

It was hoop-jumping time and the master of ceremonies, the camera men and assistants tried to help by calling and coaxing him to jump. But it only made him more indignant and confused; Lanny Lea, poor dear, was beside himself.

After a few embarrassing seconds, which seemed minutes, he condescended to jump half-heartedly. But he absolutely refused to hold the basket in his mouth so I could throw balls into it, as he has always done.

After removing the birds from the studio he forgave me and entered into the show spirit with his usual enthusiasm. This included saying his prayers, playing dead, riding in his truck with a pipe in his mouth and wearing his cap; then, on command waving his tail to the people while draped around my neck as a fur piece. It seems the more people present the harder he moves his tail to them, which would indicate his desire to show off.

In his final stunt, he truly redeemed himself. As usual he obeyed the command to go up the ladder and to walk the pole. To make it more difficult, the M. C. put the hoop in the center of the pole to make him go through



it which he did, putting himself in the M.C.'s highest esteem. Everyone agreed he had given us all a lot of extra fun and proved he was a real "ham" after all.

I want to emphatically emphasize the fact that one cannot lose his or her patience at any time. One of our interesting tricks had to be tabled because I scolded Lanny Lea. He would hold a ball on his head very still as long as I held my hand on him, but as soon as I moved my hand, he would collapse, and naturally the ball would fall. If flash bulbs and such scare your cat, do not worry because the fear will pass. Lanny Lea has completely overcome all fear of studio lights and flashbulbs and seems to know he is showing off and enjoys applause. His litter brother, also a Silver Persian neuter, is following in the footsteps of his trickster brother.

My next step is to fathom the possibilities of my Cream-colored Persian kittens. Up to now I have only taught them simple tricks.

To prove one of my above mentioned theories that all cats cannot be trained, I cite as an example my lovely Blue-cream, double champion Persian female, Lanny Lea's Moon Dust, who has won many top awards this past show season. She is sweet, lovable, has many outstanding attributes, but she lacks that something that qualifies her to become a trick cat.

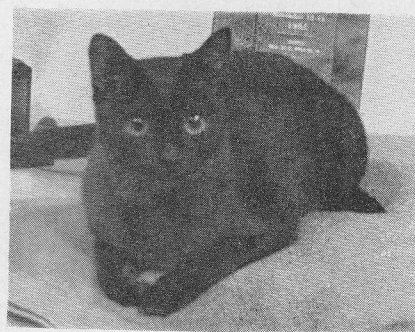
instance, some of the old Siamese Cat Registers mention Blue Points and Chocolate Points and these have been seen in Siam from time to time. More evidence of this is in an article written by Mr. H. D. Bassett over 30 years ago. It might be well to mention here that when one breeds together two recessives the result very often is a dominant.

Yes, with each generation a gene is

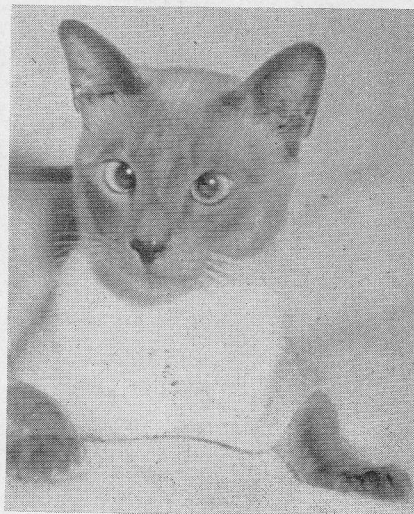
lost or picked up, but not all genes are always lost. Evidence of this is the gene for hemophilia (bleeders). In our modern generation when hemophilia is discovered the victims lineage can be traced back many generations to the Spanish Court, although no knowledge of this might have ever been known.

The recognized registering associations, other breeders and I are tired of people second guessing genetics. It's a new science hardly known by the greatest of geneticists.
