# J U D G E S' Forum

The hard-working conscientious judges of any Fancy are continually being put on the spot by exhibitors, but we suspect that this is the first time that a group of judges has been put on the spot by a magazine. Any show season must close with many pertinent questions left unanswered, but this year we felt that we could at least obtain some answers for you by querying a small but representative group of judges with three of the most pertinent questions. The gratifying response that we received follows in the ensuing paragraphs. Our only regret is that time and space limitations restricted the number of judges who could be contacted.

1. In your opinion, what factor/s (type, color, size) has/have been developed nearest the standard in today's winning cats?

## LONGHAIRS

**Mrs. Hope Johnson:** In my opinion, there has been more general improvement in head type on longhair in recent years.

**Miss Doris Hobbs:** The Best cat that I have judged at two different shows and was in beautiful condition, had type, color and size.

## SHORTHAIRES

**Sven Nelson:** Type in Siamese has come very near the standard of perfection, though some faults such as pinched muzzle or receding chin are still common. Body type, daintiness of bone in legs and feet, and length and taper of tail are

much improved. Abyssinians are slowly but surely showing better ruddiness of color and less tabby markings and white.

**Mrs. Beth O'Donovan:** Over-all extreme type in Siamese is being developed—at the sacrifice of smooth conformation. These excesses of certain points are bringing long heads with no chins at all. Also, the smooth wedge is losing out to the real pinch. I do not mean the slight pinch necessary for the placement of normal cheek bones. Heads are getting longer, but the actual wedge is being lost in irregular lines. Length of body is also getting a little out of hand through too much inbreeding. A certain amount of this is good, but line breeding and inbreeding to the extent that it is being done in some

lines is going too far; it sets the bad points along with the good.

**Mars Hanson:** Great strides have been made by Domestic Shorthair breeders in producing better color and better body type, especially in the Tabby division. I would like to see a little more concentration on head type, particularly in the area of the cheeks, and improvement in eye shape and color.

2. Where does the most work need to be done?

## LONGHAIRS

**Mrs. Hope Johnson:** Work definitely needs to be done on color, especially soundness in solid-color cats.

## SHORTHAIRES

**Sven Nelson:** Paler coats combined with greater density in point color is a goal for the Siamese breeders. Eye color and shape also need some study. In Chocolate-Points, the near-seal in color should be discarded and greater effort made to intensify the true chocolate tone. Breeding with poorly-colored Chocolates is slowing the progress of this Siamese variety.

**Mrs. Beth O'Donovan:** Good show grooming seems to be a thing of the past, except with two or three breeders whose cats come to shows in lovely condition and not too thin. I have judged some cats of extreme beauty this year in such unwholesome condition that it was pitiful.

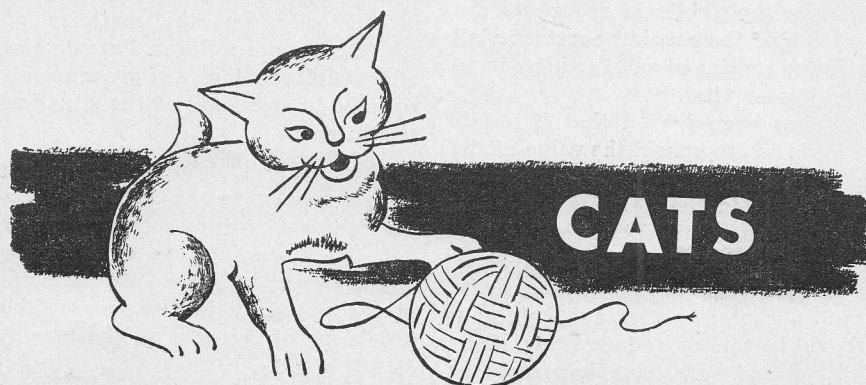
**Mars Hanson:** In the Siamese, we are seeing improved body and head type, but losing body color. Too many are too dark or have heavy shadings. Our standards describe the Seal-Point as having a pale fawn body color, lightly shaded on shoulders and flanks, and having sharply-contrasted deep point color. This distinctive pattern is lost on many of today's Siamese. This applies equally to the Blue-Points, with so many too warm in body tone, instead of the glacial white body color and "cold blue" point color which makes this one of our most beautiful cats.

3. Which is the best cat that you have judged in the past two show seasons?

## LONGHAIRS

**Mrs. Hope Johnson:** The finest cat, as to type (head, body, legs, and tail), coat texture, color, eye color, and conformation that I have handled in the past two years is Gr. Ch. Rosemont Golden Boy, cr. m., owned by Mrs. Frances Kosirowski, Detroit, Mich.

**Miss Doris Hobbs:** The best cat that I have judged in the past two show (Please turn the page)

seasons is Ch. Favors Maxim of Beverly-Serrano, Sil. m., owned by Mrs. Naomi Favors, Gas City, Ind. I feel that the cat was worthy of every win it received for the cat was not put into condition overnight. I feel that the owner has put a lot of time and work to put such a lovely cat on the bench.

### SHORTHAIRES

**Sven Nelson:** I cannot single out a lone example as the best cat that I have judged during the past two seasons, for there have been three equally good. They are Gr. Ch. Chindwin's Singumin of Newton, SP f., owned by Mrs. Arthur Cobb; Ch. Pomonock's Rascal Peiking II,

SP m., owned by Mrs. Julia Kohlus; and Ch. Mayden, blk. Manx f., owned by Mrs. Wallace Ham. These three cats stand out in my recollection as being the closest to perfection according to the requirements of the accepted standards for their breeds.

**Mrs. Beth O'Donovan:** I have been very disappointed in the Shorthairs that I have judged. I liked a very small-boned Blue-Point male whose head is very smooth, body belongs to the head, and tail is proper length for the body. Some people think a small-boned cat should have a tail as long as one of those really extreme cats. The tail should be the exact length of the body itself. This dainty male covers everything in the standard in a small package and helps to keep the overall size of the stock down. The finest Chocolate I have judged was in poor condition, his chin is weak

also, but he is the finest of his color I have seen. The Domesticats are improving rapidly. There is a fine silver Tabby in the Midwest, some in the East and one in the South. The best Seal-Point I have handled is a female in the East, but there were cats in Minneapolis that could have outdone her if they had been in better shape. I did not see the cats in the Southwest this year, but understand that they were better than those last year.

**Mars Hanson:** There have been a number of outstanding Shorthaired cats in my shows and I would like to mention in particular the lovely Sil. Tabby DSH that I found most difficult to fault—Gr. Ch. Ramayana Jenna of Gray Horse Farm, owned by Whitney Donaldson Abt, Burton, Tex. This cat is near perfection in both type and tabby markings.

## A Cat Sale Is Never Completed

Pedigreed cat buyers should have 'pedigrees', too

When selling kittens or cats, you must be salesman, advisor and a continuous source of information to the purchaser, since the breeders' responsibility does not end with the sale.

Considering the work involved in good breeding, the expense in producing attractive, healthy stock for pets as well as for breeding and show specimens, a breeder must acquire discrimination about prospective buyers. As the buyer shops for certain qualifications, color and type of what he desires, so the breeder sets up standards and qualifications for selling.

When possible, try to sell a cat or kitten that is suited to the type, personality and other requirements of the buyer. Personal characteristics are keys that can determine which kitten is best for a prospective buyer for the mutual benefit of both owner and animal.

It is wise to explain to the buyer, the responsibility and trust placed upon him in acquiring a pet; and if a cat is bought as breeding stock or for show, you must be sure that the person knows just what care is involved. It is also a good idea to give complete written instructions to the new owners for reference. Encourage them to contact you when any questions arise, or aid is needed. It is imperative that new owners learn the

fundamentals of cat care, and that they can feel free to call on you for guidance until they are capable of handling the situation alone. After all, you do not sell a cat just to remove the responsibility from yourself, but to satisfy a customer and to further your reputation as a breeder.

The breeder must also decide whether or not the prospective buyer is willing and prepared to spend time, money and effort to care for the animal in the right way. If these things are lacking, the sale should not be made. There are always people who know what they want in a pet and understand the necessary qualifications of owning a pet. But there are many also who do not, and they should never have a pet.

It has been a long hard struggle to educate the public in regard to the welfare of the cat, but constant vigil must be continued and further education is very vital.

It has been proven that if a fair price is set, to uphold the value of the cat and the breeders' investment, it will result in the new owner taking better care of his cat.

Never misrepresent stock being sold as regards its authenticity, health, characteristics and habits; it should be sold at its face value. Many kittens and cats have been sold as

pedigreed stock when they are not even registered. This practice hurts no one more than the breeder, and only serves to anger the public against cat breeders in general. The Fancy as well as the legitimate breeder must constantly guard against such practices.

Never sell kittens when you know that they will go to a home where there are very young children. Kittens are not toys; they have feelings and are sensitive. The change of homes is trying and upsetting to the animal without it being subjected to improper handling and fright. Illness and possible injury have been known to occur, and a great deal of damage is done to the personality, characteristics and habits of the animal. These factors also apply to homes where dogs have been the center of interest and are not accustomed to cats. Where children or dogs have been in supremacy in the household, hatred, jealousy and other psychological effects can be fatal to a cat or kitten. There have been situations such as these which were worked out satisfactorily, but the majority of such cases were failures. Parents and other adults in the family cannot always be in command of the situation at all times.

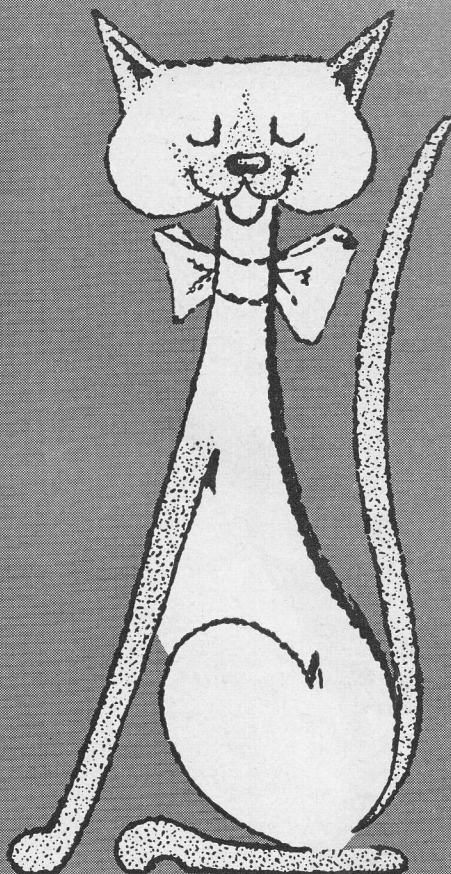
Thoroughly explain the difference in prices between the pet cat and a breeder or show-type cat; whether or not the price includes the papers, registrations and inoculations, shipping cost, etc. It is wise to note the provisions of the sale on the receipt or bill of sale.

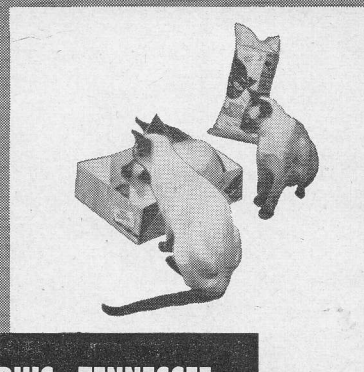

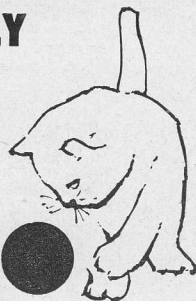

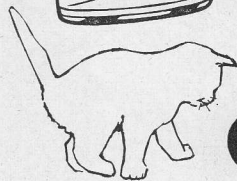

The non-infectious diseases are many times a greater problem in the maintenance of a healthy animal than the specific infectious diseases. The specific ones often, in fact usually, have one treatment and that is a successful one; whereas, the non-specific condition presents an open field and a variety of treatments will be tried with a variety of results.

Please keep in mind that over-dosing or over-treatment will likely create a sick animal even though there is no other actual disease present. Logic and good judgement in treating animals are apt to be as important or more so than the medicines used.

Nursing and good care, with proper housing and correct food, are important aids that are often of more real benefit to the patient than a "tummy" full of drugs. The drugs are more apt to upset the animal's system and thus outweigh any good that might come from the drug action.

Proper medication following a correct diagnosis has great value, while improper medication is usually dangerous, especially following an incorrect diagnosis.

The following are a few non-infectious conditions which commonly are seen in pet animals and which lend themselves to wise treatment with pleasing results in most instances.

PARASITES, internal (worms) and external (fleas, lice and ticks) rob animals of health and strength as well as transmitting many diseases. They are about the most costly luxury a living creature can possess.

Fleas, lice and ticks are readily visible and easily identified. They can be controlled by one of the numerous preparations on the market. Just be careful to read the label and be certain the preparation (powder, liquid or soap) is safe for the particular species of animal involved. Meticulously clean the animal's house and bed at the same time that you treat the animal; carry the cleaning throughout the house or apartment, otherwise the creature will simply become reinfested.

Indiscriminate worming often is a dangerous extravagance. Determine what, if any, intestinal parasite (roundworm, tapeworm, hookworm, whipworm, etc.) is infesting your pet. If worms are proven to be present by seeing them in the stool or by finding their ova under the microscope, then you can intelligently proceed to treat the animal according to its needs. Be particularly careful to avoid dosing a sick animal for worms. It is better to overcome the primary illness first and then eliminate the worms, if and when present.

Inflamed eyes can be relieved as well as cleansed by carefully sponging with pledgets of cotton soaked in a solution of boric acid and Borax, one teaspoonful of each in a pint of warm water. Be careful to avoid mechanically injuring the eye ball.

Ear canals may be cleaned or discharge removed with pledgets of cotton, on an applicator stick, that have been soaked in olive oil at body temperature. Be gentle and do not try to "bore" to the bottom of the ear canal.

Eczemas are apt to be caused by some insect (fleas), external irritants (pollens and weed rusts), or an allergic reaction to food or chemicals. Eliminate the cause where possible. With a change of diet, especially to one predominantly of fresh foods, relief should be noted in a reasonably short time. Topical applications to the affected skin of simple lotions or ointments will likely reduce the itching and hasten healing.

**Q.** I would like to know what to do for my cat who has scratched bare spots near her ears and is shedding her hair all over. She hasn't any fleas that I know of.

**A.** I would suspect mange and suggest that, if possible, you consult your local veterinarian for treatment. Plain Iodex applied daily to the affected parts might be helpful but not necessarily curative.
